



There is so much that the orphanage, medical clinic and widows need:

WIDOWS' HOMES

They need four widows' homes on the property in Carrefour which is in the southern suburb of Port-au-Prince.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The existing Medical Clinic is located on the Carrefour property which is 5 miles from the national office in Haiti. It is operating with very basic necessities. They have extensive needs. It would help tremendously to have a clinic extension at the orphanage in Dufailly so that they would not have to transport the children to the main medical clinic unless it was an emergency.

ORPHANAGE

The current orphanage is located in Dufailly which is 35 miles from Haiti's National Office. They only have a small charcoal burning kitchen in the rear of the orphanage for cooking with very few pots and pans. Food was taken to the orphanage back in September of 2010 and the pastor/director of the orphanage asked when they would be back with more food. Contact was made with Operation Compassion, David Lorency, and arrangements are in the works to make more food available.

There are no toilets or showers in the orphanage.

They need running water, proper ventilation and electricity.

Currently, the orphanage is acquiring power from other sources.

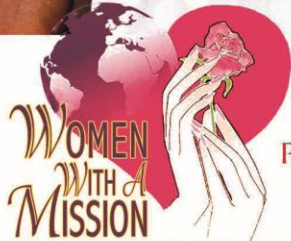
A new orphanage building will increase the number of orphans that they can minister to and help us fulfill James 1:27. Please help make this dream a reality!

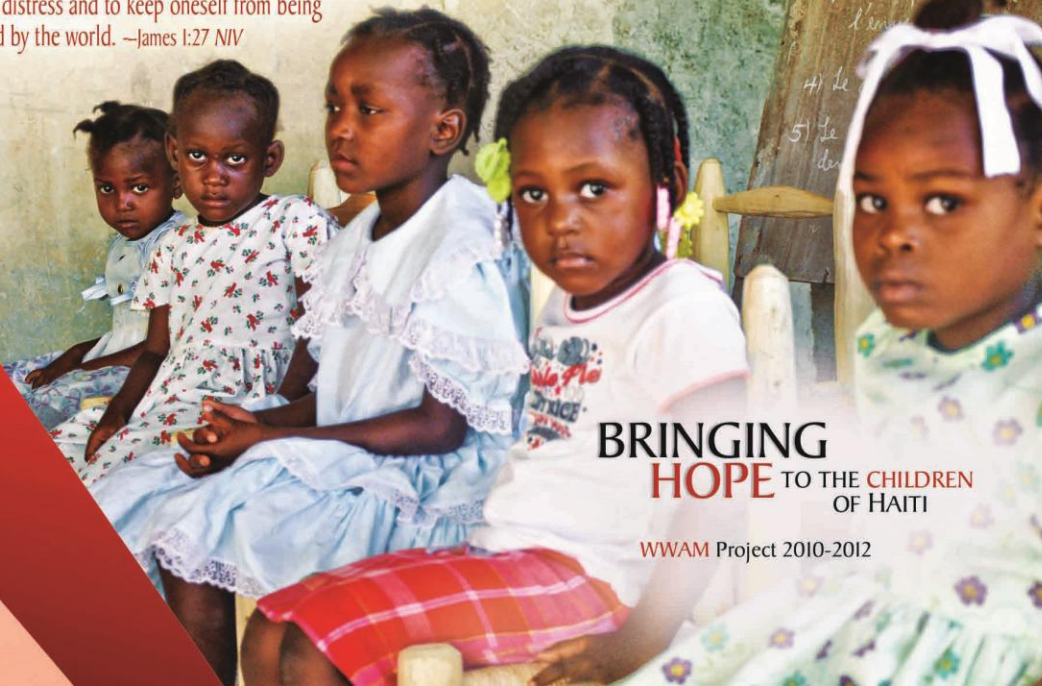
